Routines: To ensure reading book and reading record are brought to school every day. I will monitor reading records on Monday and reward children with a sticker if they have read at least 3 times during the week. This can be any book, text on the computer, etc. Remember comprehension is just as important as reading the words. We do different types of reading in class - shared, guided and individual. If anyone would like to volunteer to hear readers an afternoon a week speak to myself or office.

In June, Year 1 and some Year 2 children will take a phonic test which is made up of 40 words some real and some pretend based upon knowledge of sounds. In May, Year 2s will take SAT tests. There will be 2 reading papers, SPAG paper, Maths arithmetic and Maths reasoning.

Spellings - 10 spellings each Friday. Bring spelling folder each Friday. Assess how children get on with spellings then give them a target. If they achieve their target get a sticker. Once they have achieved 10 they will get a certificate in assembly.

Handwriting - cursive style, share booklet.

We aim for independence, pride in our work and good manners.

Share class rules that children compiled themselves.

Great mate - We have a great mate each week. Children choose on a Friday, but everyone will get the opportunity. That child is then the

special helper the following week, gets to be the leader, special jobs, etc.

Zone board - everyone starts on green, if children are seen showing good learning behaviours they get to move up to silver, then gold. If they need more than a reminder they will be moved down. If they are on silver or gold at the end of the day they will get a raffle ticket. One ticket will be picked out of the special box on a Friday.

P.E. - P.E. days are Wednesday and Friday but a good idea to keep in school and take home on a Friday.
